Tyler AND Bates 003996-R2 at timestamp

This is the high-profile case involving Tyler James Robinson (charged with aggravated murder and related counts in the September 10, 2025, shooting of Charlie Kirk at Utah Valley University).

“Bates 003996-R2” is a **Bates-stamped discovery exhibit** (standard numbering used by the prosecution/Utah County Attorney’s Office when producing large volumes of materials to the defense). It refers to a **video recording** (likely bodycam, stationhouse interview, or surveillance footage) of Tyler Robinson’s encounter with law enforcement. The video shows him being read his Miranda rights at approximately 6:25 p.m. MDT on September 11, 2025 (with an internal video timestamp around 03:36:53 or similar, depending on the exact frame). The exhibit has been referenced in recent defense filings and analysis (particularly around late March 2026) to highlight alleged timeline discrepancies: Robinson was already in custody and mirandized (and reportedly invoked his right to counsel) hours before the official “surrender” narrative and a Discord confession message attributed to him. Where to access related court documents

Full discovery exhibits like the raw video (Bates 003996-R2) are **not publicly posted online** (they are part of voluminous defense discovery—thousands of files, hundreds of hours of video/audio—and subject to redactions/court controls).
